Exciting changes have come to the AAEA publications portfolio. The restructuring has resulted in *Choices* being merged with *Applied Economics Teaching Resources (AETR)*, which has been renamed *Applied Economics Education and Extension (AEEE)*, and *Applied Economics Perspectives* and *Applied Economics Perspectives and Policy (AEPP)*. Under the excellent leadership of editors Zhengfei Guan and Ruiqing Miao, *Choices* has grown rapidly. The journal's current scale and quality position it to move on to stronger platforms offered by *AEEE* and *AEPP*.

Building on the legacies of *AETR* and *Choices*, *Applied Economics Education and Extension (AEEE)* will now feature a section entitled Applied Economic Insights that provide coverage of national and international applied economics issues related to education, teaching, extension, outreach, industry education, and teaching. These are articles in the style of *Choices* that are authoritative, non-technical overviews, reviews, and analysis of emerging applied economic issues and topics suitable for use in industry, extension, outreach, and education settings.

Applied Economics Perspectives and Policy will publish articles that advance discussion of critical emerging policy issues, carrying on the *Choices* legacy.

Context for the Restructuring

The merger of *Choices* with *AETR* and *AEPP* creates a stronger and more visible platform for applied economics education and outreach.
